



**Specific Agreement for Student Exchange
Between
the University of Guadalajara, Mexico
and
Seoul National University, Republic of Korea**

The University of Guadalajara and Seoul National University, wishing to strengthen their academic relations and productive cooperation between both universities, agree to the following:

ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to initiate student exchange between Seoul National University and the University of Guadalajara.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF THE COOPERATION

The parties agree to participate in a student exchange agreement, whereby the University of Guadalajara agrees to accept a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 5 (five) students from Seoul National University per year. The duration of the exchange study period is 1 (one) semester or 1 (one) academic year. In reciprocation, the University of Guadalajara, agrees to send a commensurate number of its students to Seoul National University, beginning from March 2007, and to run for 5 (five) years. This agreement may be renewed by mutual consent.

ARTICLE 3: FINANCIAL AND ACADEMIC

- 3.1 Students participating in this program will pay tuition fees in their home university and will be exempted from this payment at their host university. All other expenses such as accommodation, living, travel, etc., must be cover by the students.



- 3.2 The academic extension programs of the University of Guadalajara offered by its university enterprises, the Centro de Estudios para Extranjeros (CEPE) and the Sistema Corporativo PROULEX - COMLEX are not included in this agreement.
- 3.3 The home university will select and postulate their students who fulfil the admission requirements established by the host university.
- 3.4 For admittance purposes, the home university will submit to the host university, the required certified documents of the students selected, by the deadline set by the host university.
- 3.5 The conversion of academic credits earned during the academic stay in the host university will be made according to the home institution's regulations and criteria.

ARTICLE 4: ADMINISTRATION

- 4.1 Each University will designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities for the student exchange program.
- 4.2 Students participating in the exchange program will be given advice about housing and each university will give priority for on-campus housing to students participating in this student exchange agreement.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY OF THIS AGREEMENT

- 5.1 This agreement will take effect from the date of signature for an initial period of 5 (five) years. Thereafter, it will be automatically extended for an additional 5 (five) years at each expiration date unless either party provides written notice to terminate the agreement a minimum of six



months prior to the expiration date. Such notice of termination will not interfere with cooperative programs currently underway. Such programs will be allowed to continue until their conclusion.

5.2 Both parties, having read the present document and with the understanding of the content and extent of each of its clauses, indicating the absence of malice, dishonesty or any other reason to nullify their consent, this document is signed in duplicate in English and Spanish, both versions with the same content and validity.
